


Brake caliper piston retractor tool 206-080




Crankshaft pulley/damper remover 303-588


Removal

- 1. Carry out the parking brake cable tension release procedure.
- 2. Remove both rear wheels and tires.







- 3. Detach the parking brake cable.
- 1. Reposition the <u>brake caliper</u> lever.
- 2. Detach the parking brake cable.



- 4. Detach the parking brake cable.
- Release the retaining tangs.
 Detach the <u>parking brake cable</u>.




- 5. Rotate the brake caliper upwards.
- 1. Remove and discard the brake caliper lower retaining bolt.
- 2. Rotate the brake caliper upwards.



- 6. Remove the brake pads.
 - · Remove the brake pad anti-rattle spring plates.

Installation




- 1. WARNING: DO NOT USE A COMPRESSED AIR TO DISPERSE BRAKE DUST INTO THE ATMOSPHERE.
 - CAUTION: If the pistons are pushed back into the housing, <u>brake fluid</u> will be forced back into the brake fluid
 reservoir.
 - CAUTION: Make sure that the brake disc faces are clean before installation.
 - CAUTION: Brake pads must always be replaced in axle sets.


NOTE: Remove the forcing screw from the crankshaft pulley/damper remover and install to the brake caliper piston retractor tool.

Using the special tools, fully retract the brake caliper pistons.






2. Make sure the <u>brake caliper</u> piston location mark is in the correct position so that the locator pin on the brake pad locates correctly into the brake caliper piston.




3. **NOTE:** Remove the forcing screw from the <u>brake caliper</u> piston retractor tool and install to the crankshaft pulley/damper remover.

Install new brake pads.


• Install the brake pad anti-rattle spring plates.



- 4. Install a new brake caliper lower retaining bolt.
 - Tighten to 34 Nm .



5. Attach the parking brake cable.
